

Non-Fiction Text Feature Matching—Lower Elementary Level

Tables, Graphs, or Charts	Words close to a picture or photo that help you understand the picture or photo
Photographs/Illustrations	Helps you can look at something from the inside
Captions	A list of chapter titles from the book
Cutaway	Helps you see where places are in the world
Table of Contents	Helps you know what words are important; Words might be <u>underlined</u> , bold or in <i>italics</i>
Glossary	A list in ABC order of things in the book, with page numbers
Index	Helps you know what the book will be all about (the main idea)
Maps	Help you name the parts of a photo or picture
Special Print	Help you know what something looks like
Titles/Subtitles	Helps you know what words from the book mean
Labels	Help you see information from the text in chart form

Non-Fiction Text Feature Matching-Upper Elementary Level

Tables, Charts, Graphs	Words written close to a picture or photograph to help the reader understand the picture or photograph
Photographs/Illustrations	Helps reader understand something by looking at it from the inside
Captions	Helps the reader identify key topics in the book in the order they are presented
Cutaway	Help the reader understand where places are in the world
Table of Contents	Helps the reader to know which words or ideas are important. Words might be, <u>underlined</u> , bold or in <i>italics</i> .
Glossary	An alphabetical list of almost everything in the text, with page numbers
Index	Gives the reader a general idea what the text will be about
Maps	Help the reader identify a photograph or a picture and its parts
Special Print	Help the reader know exactly what something looks like
Titles/Subtitles	Helps the reader define words that are in the book
Labels	Help the reader see information in a diagram form
