Mom made cookies for the family. Each tray had ten cookies on it. If she made four trays, how many cookies did mom make?

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Six girls are swinging on the swings. How many eyes are there?

There are five vans going to the zoo. Each van can hold five people. How many people are going to the zoo?

Jan has six boxes of crayons. Each box holds ten crayons. How many crayons does Jan have?

There are seven boys walking in their flip flops. How many toes are there?
