

# My Candy Hearts

Sorting the Two Sounds of Final Y (e and i)



Directions:

Using the *my* and *candy* heart boxes as headers, ask students to sort the words on each heart under the correct candy box based on its vowel pattern.

\*Print onto cardstock and laminate pieces for durability.

Sorting Key:

MY: why, fly, pry, dry, fry, cry, spy, try, by

CANDY: happy, baby, pretty, easy, funny, thirty, city, party, penny



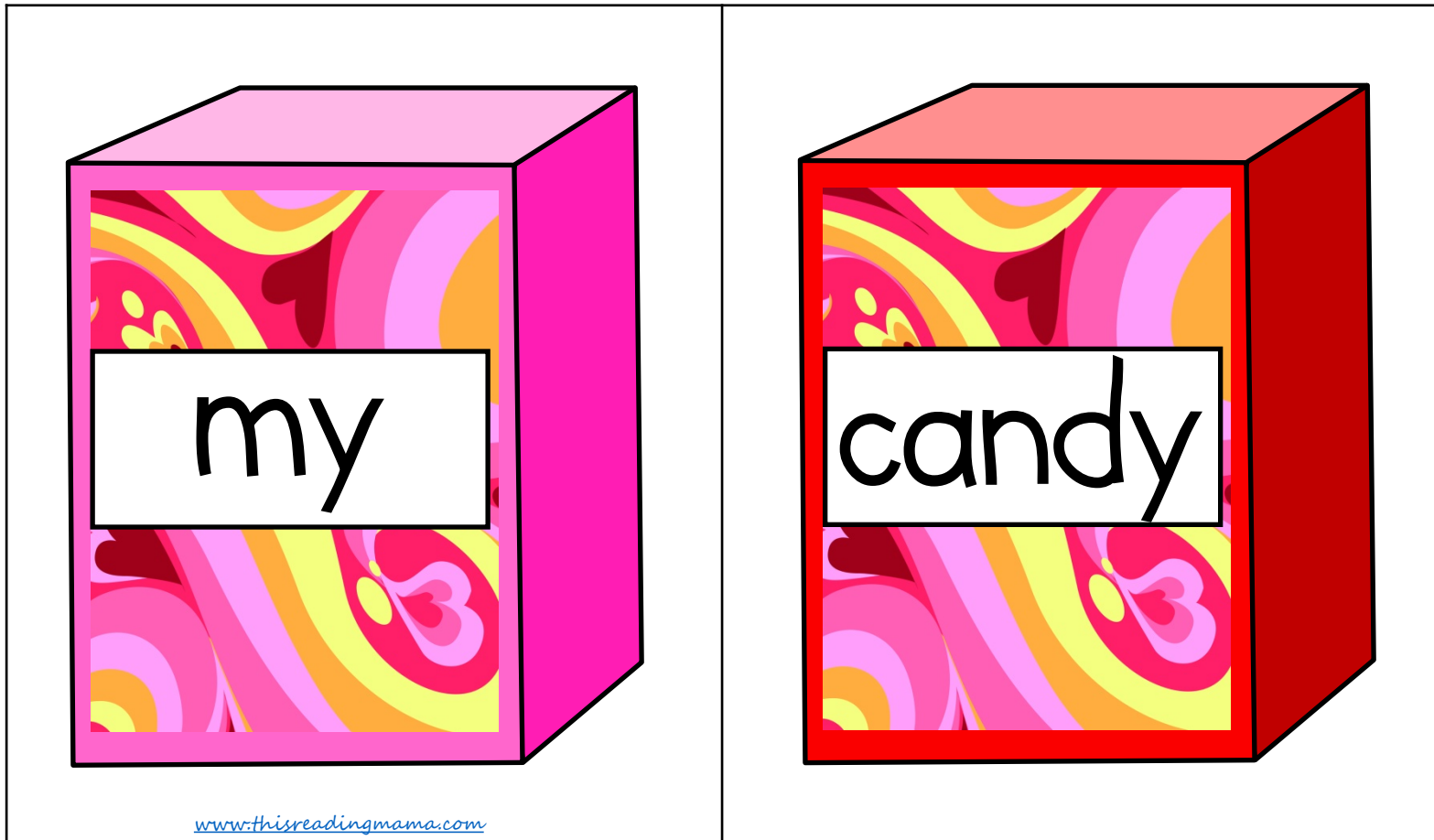
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# My Candy Hearts: Sorting the Two Sounds of Final Y

**Directions:** Cut apart the Valentine Heart boxes and heart pieces. Sort each candy heart under the box in which it belongs, based on the pattern (y says long e or long i).

**Generalization:** y on the end of a two-syllable word makes the long e sound and y on the end of a one-syllable word make the long i sound.



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
