

How Many Vultures in the Tree?

Print the mat (pg. 2) and number cards onto cardstock and laminate for durability.

VERSION 1 (easier)

- *Place some vultures on the tree mat (pg. 2).
- *Ask your child to count the number of vultures.
- *Help him locate the number (from the number cards, pg. 4)



VERSION 2 (harder)

- *Place some vultures on the tree mat (pg. 2).
- *Ask your child to count the number of vultures.
- *Help him locate and trace the correct number (with the number tracer cards, pp. 5-6)

VERSION 3 (hardest)

- *Using the tree mat (pg. 2), place some vultures on the mat and then more.
- *Pose is as a problem to the child such as "There were 4 vultures in the tree. Then 2 more came along. How many vultures are there now?"
- *The child solves the problem and locates the number (from pg. 4) or locates AND traces the number (with the number tracer cards, pp. 5-6)





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Number Tracing Cards 1-20

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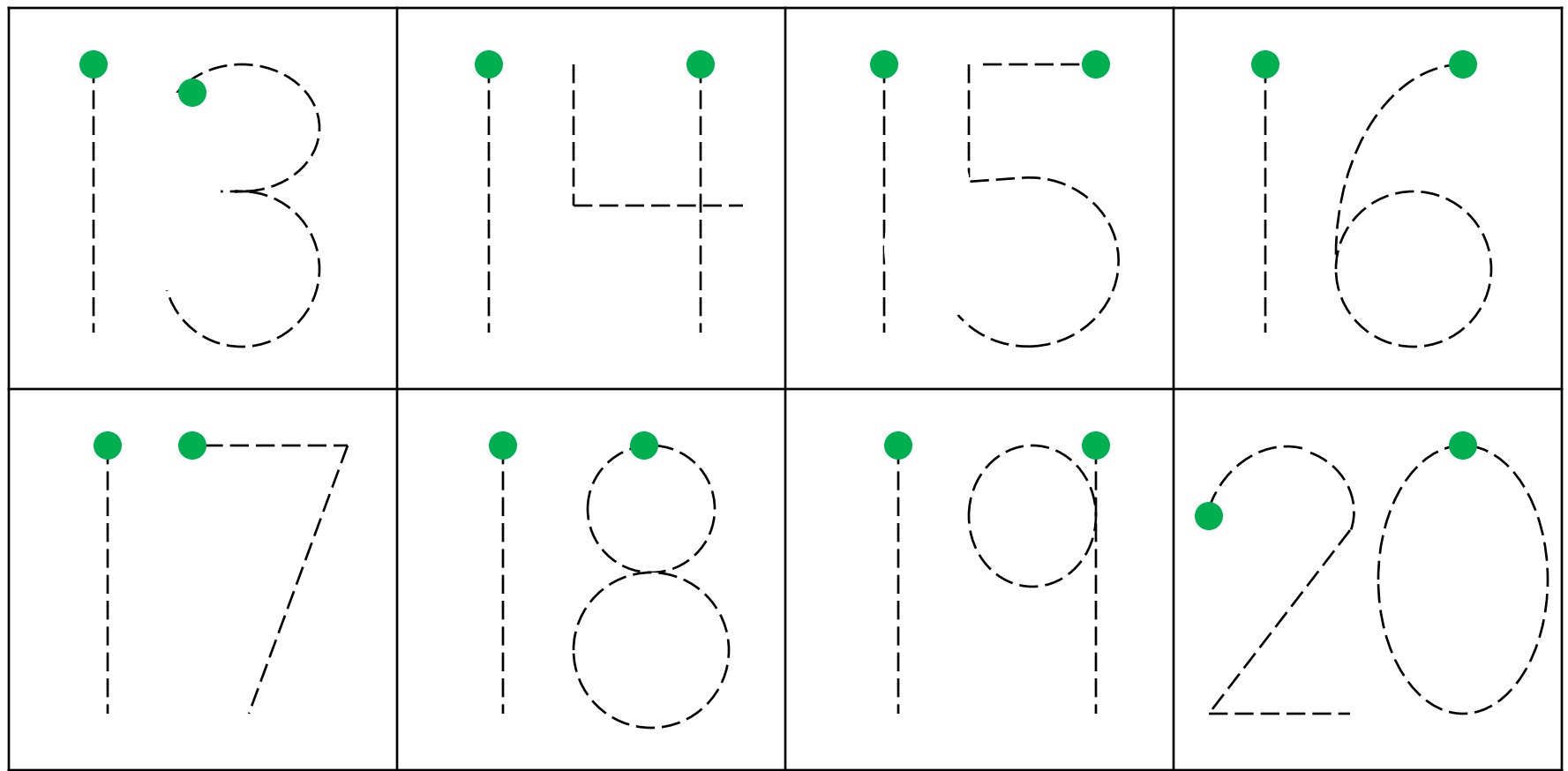
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**The green dot indicates where the child should start writing the number.*
