
Directions:


- •On a paper plate, ask your child to draw or create a few of his favorite vegetables. •Cut out and mix up this sentence.
- •Lay out all the words so the child can see them. Say the sentence in the correct order and let him help you put them back in the right order.
- •You can glue them down on a piece of paper and attach to the paper plate.
- •Read the sentence out loud, pointing to each word as you read it.
- •Ask the child to try it, too!





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




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Carrot Poke Page



How To Use:

*Print the carrot poke page onto regular copy paper.

*Place on top of carpet.

*Using a toothpick or push pin, poke holes along the outline of the carrot.


*Place on a window and let the light shine through!

Variations:

*Tape a piece of construction paper under poke page and poke through both pieces. When finished poking holes, remove poke page and place the construction paper carrot on a window to let the light shine through!

*Place in a plastic sleeve protector and trace the carrot with dry erase markers.

*Place stickers all along the outline of the carrot.




Carrot Poke Page

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Garden Cutting Practice & Pattern Cards

*I recommend printing these onto cardstock to make it easier for the child to cut.

*To prepare for the child, cut along the darker, horizontal lines first to create 4 separate strips. (like the strip below)




*Give the strips to the child and ask her to cut along each dotted line to make six separate picture cards for each row.

*This can be used as a stand-alone cutting activity OR the little cards can then be used to make patterns together with your child.

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Garden Cutting Practice & Pattern Cards



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To Prep:

*Print onto cardstock and laminate for durability. (Print one seed game board and one pea plants page for each player) *Cut apart pea plants on dotted lines.

*Locate a die, labeled 1-6.

To Play: (for 2 players)

*Each player needs a game board and 20 pea plants.

*The first player rolls the die, counts the number of dots, and places that many pea plants on top of his game board. For example, if the player rolls a 2, he takes two pea plants and covers up two of his seeds on his game board.

*The first player to "grow" all of his seeds, wins!

Variations: 1- If only one person is playing, he continues to roll and count the dots, placing pea plants onto his game board until they are all covered.


2-The pea plant page can be used as a cutting exercise before the game is played. Just cut along all the horizontal dotted lines and ask the child to cut along all the vertical lines.




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
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
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


Garden Numbers 10-20




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
Garden Numbers – 1 die



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


Garden Numbers – 2 dice



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How Many Carrots in the Garden?

Print the mat and number cards onto cardstock and laminate for durability.

VERSION 1 (easier)

*Place some carrots on the garden mat. *Ask your child to count the number of carrots. *Help him locate the number (from Number Cards 1-20).

VERSION 2 (harder)

*Place some carrots on the garden mat. *Ask your child to count the number of carrots. *Help him locate **and** trace the correct number (with the number tracer cards)

VERSION 3 (hardest)

*Place some carrots on the left side of the mat and more on the right side.

*Pose is as a problem to the child such as "There were 3 carrots in the garden. Then 2 more grew. How many carrots are there now?"


*The child solves the problem and locates the number (from Number Cards 1-20) OR locates and traces the number (with the number tracer cards.)

Those children who are ready for it could write the number without tracing or write the number sentence!



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


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
Cut out carrots and use to place on the garden mat. You could also use items such as orange pom-poms with small tongs, orange jewels, or small carrot erasers to incorporate some fine motor work.
