Shape Writing: pp. 12-19

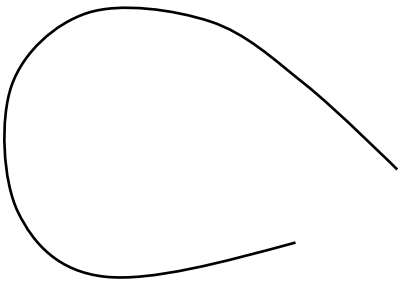

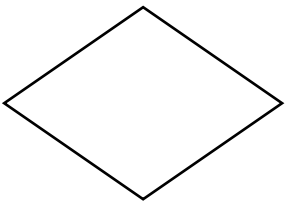

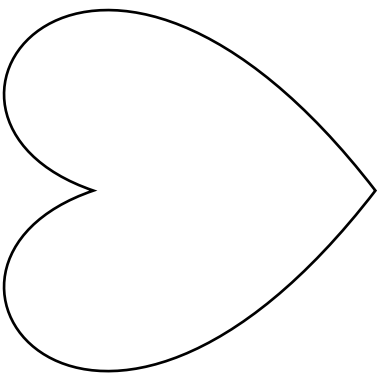

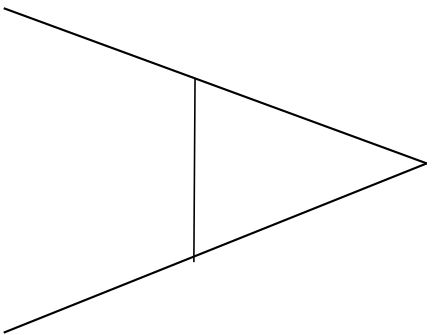

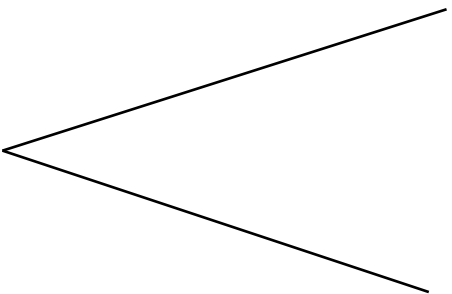

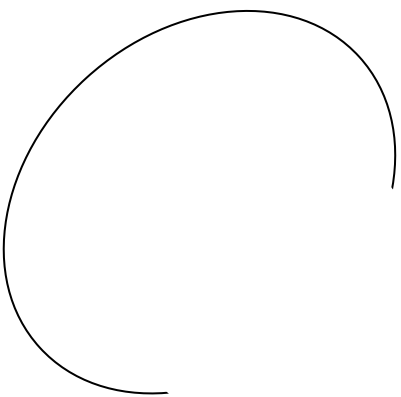

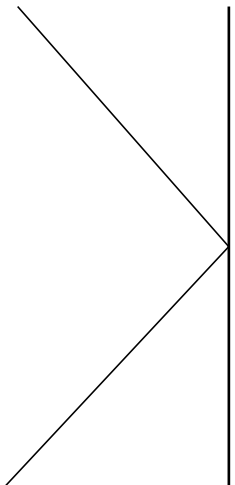

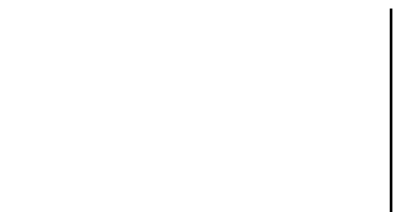

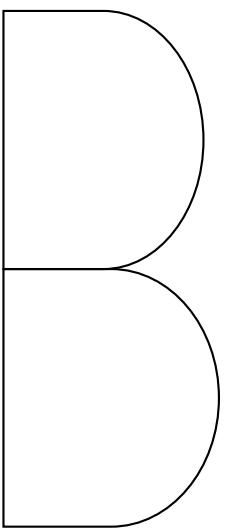

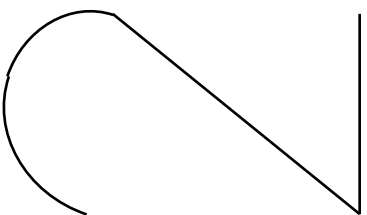

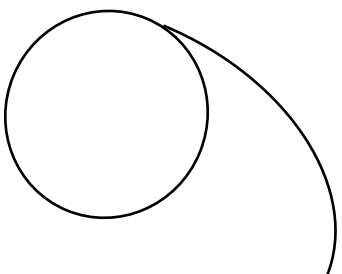

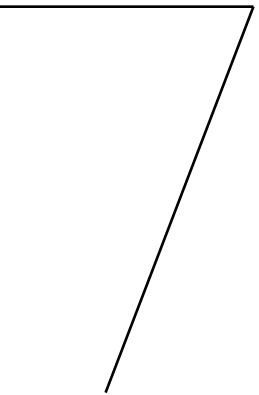
