

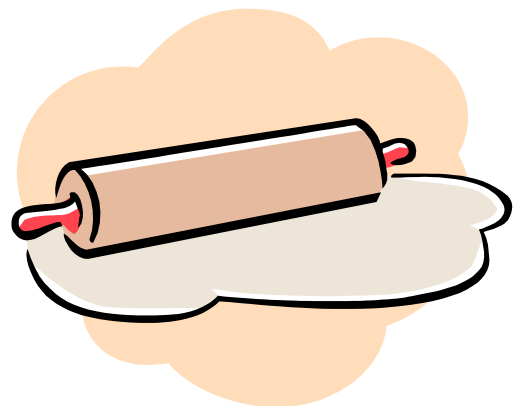
Alphabet Playdough Mats

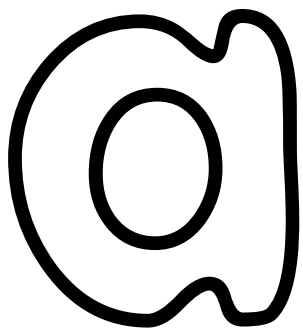
Combine playdough and letter learning!

Directions:

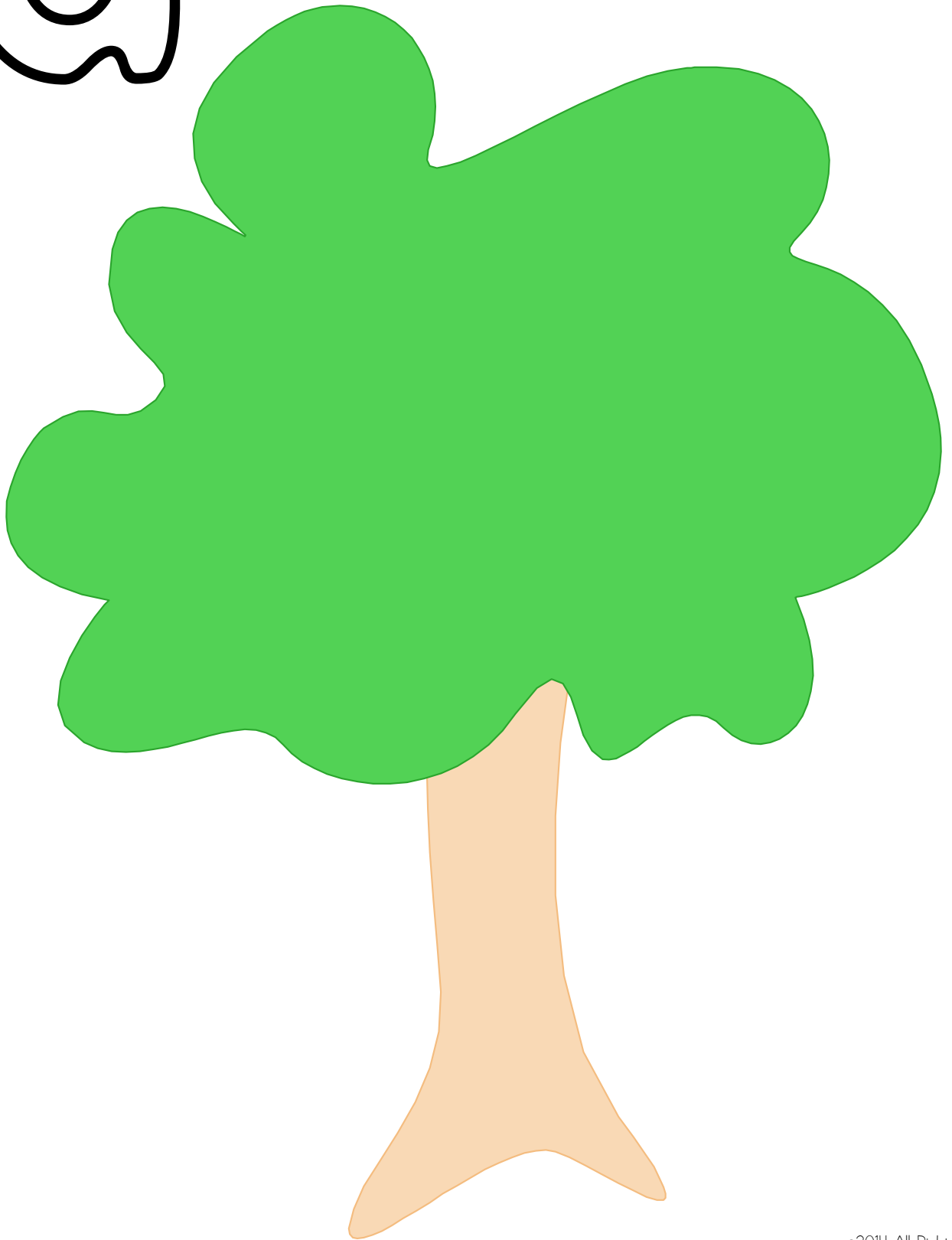
- Place the mat in a plastic sleeve protector (or laminate for durability).
