



Bendy Sticks Spelling

pg. 2 - accommodates up to 4-letter words

pg. 3- accommodates up to 6-letter words

- Place the spelling page you want (pg. 2 or 3) in a plastic sleeve protector or laminate for durability.
- Using a kind of bendy stick (like you find in this post), ask the child to form and spell words.
- Then, have the child use another piece of paper (or pg. 4/5 of this download) to record the words he has spelled.

This activity works well for a literacy/spelling center in a classroom, for after school spelling practice, tutoring session, or homeschool setting. Enjoy!


