

Thank You Cards

- Print the thank you cards onto copy paper or cardstock.
- Place in a basket or in a location that can be reached by kids.
- When you “catch” them doing something without being asked or when you just want to drop them a note to tell them thank you, pick a card and write a quick thank you note.
- Leave it where the child can see it.
- **Encourage kids to do the same for you and for each other.** This is such an authentic way to sneak in some writing and encourage thankfulness!!
- Included in the pack are small notecards, medium-sized cards and single sheets of paper for writing longer letters.

These can be used ANY time of year. We used them around Thanksgiving as you can see here;
