


Advent Writing Activity

- After reading the Scripture passage and talking about the name of Jesus that coincides with the reading, kids can extend their learning by writing about the name of Jesus.
- Younger kids can draw their explanations, while older kids should write theirs.
- Do not stress about spellings, instead focus on the meaning.
- Kids can use these each day or only on some days. Pages could even be hole-punched and kept as a journal.
