

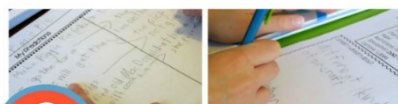
# Making Predictions Pack



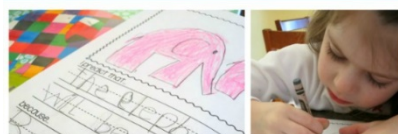
When readers make predictions, they combine the clues the author has given them in the text with their background knowledge.

  - Writing about predictions (nonfiction), pg. 5

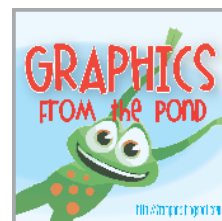
