Phoneme Counting Cards

PREP

Print counting cards onto card stock and laminate for durability.

PLAY

- Name the object on the card.
- Say the name of the object a little slower, emphasizing each phoneme, or sound in the word.
- The child places one counter for each phoneme in the boxes under each picture, starting with the left box. For
 example, plug has four phonemes. So, one counter would be placed in the boxes for each phoneme: p I u g.
- Then the child counts how many phonemes are in each word. (See our post for further directions.)





Picture Key:

- 2 phonemes: up, bee, ice, zoo
- 3 phonemes: sheep, pig, night, sock, thumb, duck, bead, chop, ship, wig, shop
- 4 phonemes: frog, block, brick, scoop, plug, spot, fox, brush, queen
- 5 phonemes: donut, gloves, quilt, scuba, muffin, grapes, robot, rabbit
