

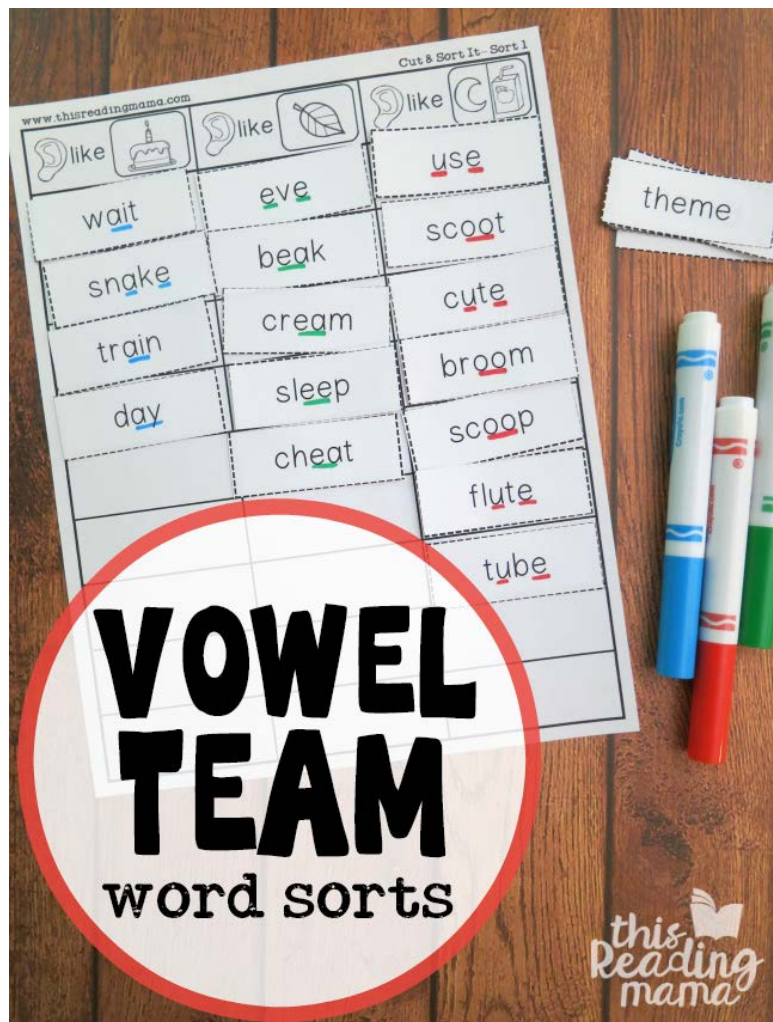
Vowel Team Word Sorts
